***As LWHS plans for 2020-2021, our guiding principle is to keep the health and safety of the students and educators as a top priority.***

### **1. Traditional On-Site Option**

LWHS parents who would like their son or daughter to participate in the on campus option will need to understand that this is a 9 week commitment with other students present. Our traditional option will enable us to serve as many students as we possibly can on site in accordance with CDC guidelines. In addition, we will be in consultation with the Polk County Health Department and Covid medical experts as we implement this plan. If your son or daughter does not have any health issues and they, perhaps, struggled with the remote learning option in the Spring, you may want to consider this option. The school day will follow a bell schedule and the students will have their core courses taught following the FI Standards. Changes will include smaller classes and changes to ensure the health and safety of each student on campus.

#### **Expectations for on-campus students:**

- Masks at all times, unless a student is eating breakfast or lunch
- Must practice social distancing per CDC guidelines
- Frequent use of hand sanitizer located in every classroom and in common spaces
- Help staff members to keep the environment safe
- Symptom screening will occur as needed
- Temperatures will be checked periodically throughout the day
- No student can attend with any symptoms or high temperature
- Students who test positive must quarantine and move to the Innovative Academic Instruction during that time. A copy of a negative test result is required for your student to be able to return to the traditional option.
- Students will agree to follow reconfigured hallway one-way directions
- At all times students will be respectful of the educators at LWHS and be in school uniform

If a family thinks a student would have a difficult time living up to these expectations, the Innovative Academic instruction model may be a better fit.

## **2. Innovative Academic instruction**

LWHS will enable parents who would like the lowest risk option for their son or daughter to select the Innovative Academic Instruction model. The students will complete assignments in Schoology. Teachers will provide instruction on Florida Standards through instructional videos, live lessons, online lectures and discussion, interactive notebooks, collaborative opportunities, and extended learning experiences. LWHS will have one-to-one & group tutoring provided by the staff member or our Academic Coaches. The Innovative Academic Instruction (IAI) model will also include opportunities for morning meetings, grade level meetings, and CREW. We will seek to build a vibrant virtual community for our students. LWHS will ensure that students with IEP, 504, ELL plans will be honored through virtual support and on campus meetings, if needed.
