2020-2021 School Year

Q: ARE WE READY FOR SCHOOL TO BEGIN? A: ABSOLUTELY, UNEQUIVOCALLY, YES!

Q: When is the office open from now until August 31st?

A: 9:00 am - 3:30 pm Monday-Friday; If you want to meet with a specific staff member, please call to make an appointment.

Q: What time does the school day start/end?

A: 8:30 am - 3:20 pm

Q: Do we still have H2H and Morning Meetings?

A: No. We will not have either of these until CDC recommendations have changed.

Q: How long will my child be online?

A: All students will be online for week one (August 24th-28th). The second week will begin the instructional model they have chosen.

Q: What if we don't have internet access at home?

A: A parent can call the front office and our receptionist will ensure you are placed on the list. Simply tell them you are requesting internet access.

Q: How are students at home getting access to meals?

A: Our Food Service Director will be providing information soon.

Q: What is happening will Fall Sports this year?

A: As of August 18, conditioning began. We will try to keep you informed. Any further changes will be made in consultation with the state and local public health officials, Advent Health Covid Specialist, and attorney, Robin Gibson.

Q: WHAT ARE THE MAIN DIFFERENCES WE WILL SEE ON CAMPUS THIS YEAR?

A: We have added lots of new procedures to help keep our students safe including:

- Hallway traffic will be one way only
- Mandatory masks on campus
- Socially distant in classrooms (6ft apart)
- Covid Health Screening room
- Some staff will be teaching remotely and not on campus
- Hand sanitizing stations throughout campus
- H2H modified to three lunches
- Temperature checks as students arrive
- Additional cleaning staff on campus at all times

9TH GRADERS-

Q: How do 9th graders receive their email address and Schoology access?

A: Instructions for this will be mailed to the address provided. Parents will have their access information mailed by September 1, 2020.

Q: What is being mailed to 9th graders and new students?

A: Class schedule, bell schedule, map of the school, letter on food service, and uniform expectations.

10TH-12TH GRADERS-

Q: How will 10th-12th graders receive schedules?

A: Schedules will be sent through Schoology.

Q: What do students do when they arrive at school?

A: Bus Riders- Temperatures will be checked before entering the bus. At school, a staff member will give instructions on where you can be.

Car Riders- More information coming soon.

Q: Are parents allowed to enter the main office?

A: The receptionist will greet parents and visitors at an outdoor workspace located directly in front of the main office. They will set appointments and try to answer all of your questions.
